The latest results of Student Destinations Survey show that 70% of Cambridge students progressed to one of the world's top 500 universities last year. In total, 94% of students who took the Cambridge International AS & A Level curriculum moved on to university. Of those, 58% stayed in their own country, including many students from Pakistan, Indonesia and the US, who traditionally study locally. The other 36% progressed to universities internationally and, despite the pandemic, the UK, US, Canada and Australia were still the most sought-after destinations. 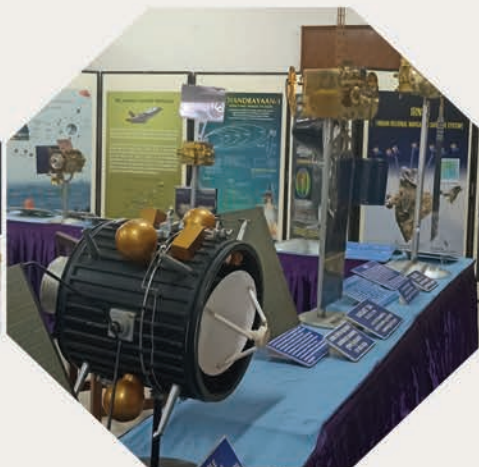


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SCIENCE FAIR EXHIBITION

Around 34 students and ten teachers participated in the event. The exhibition started at 9:30 am and was opened to many schools and colleges that day. The students were welcomed with a magic show followed by alchemy tunnel which led to the chemistry department. Experiments of orange peel explosion, dancing flames, bouncing egg, walking water helped everyone to understand the concepts behind all working models. Then we saw real life organs from dead bodies, dead foetus which is preserved in biology laboratory and many other systems like excretory system, DNA structures, terrariums. Then we entered English department where they showed the significance of globe theatre, oil on canvas from 1503 to 1915. Our students went around looking at the new trends in ICTs, different working models designed by students of physics departments and its descriptions. The event was held in cooperation with VSSC, Planetarium, Horticultural department of India, Rubber research institute of India, Forest life department, Kerala agricultural university, medical college and other government sectors and many more. 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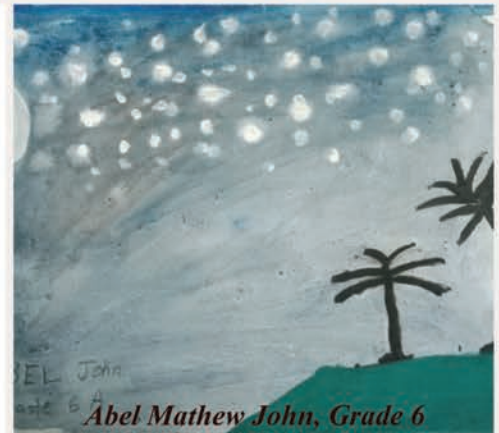
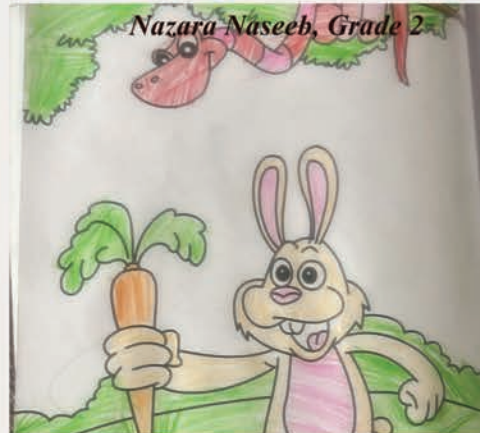

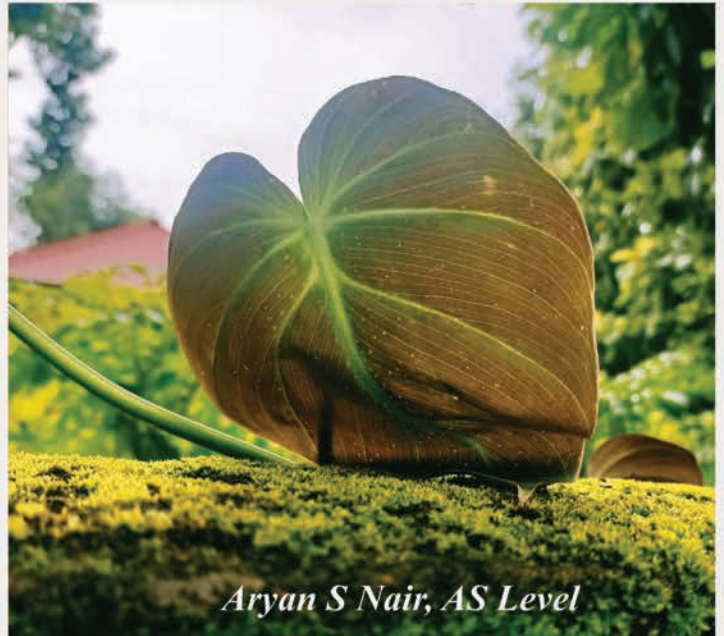
